## Reality TV Group Psychotherapy

**T**HIS IS THE FIRST REALITY TV GROUP PSYCHOTHERAPY to air throughout the country (and on YouTube.) On two separate evenings, Dr. Goldberg will screen segments of the program at CMPS—each followed by discussion. Modern psychoanalytic group techniques can be studied *in vivo* as conflicts arise naturally in the group process and the group's leader applies interventions. Freud's concept of *eros* (love) and *thanatos* (death/aggression) are evident as group members struggle to find safe, yet authentic footing with one another. A social gathering follows the event.
